## KRAS (Slovenia)

1. **Kopriva, three hiške (temporary shelter) nearby:** at Rova, in Dolina, in Zaboršt, interwar period. Stonemason Andrej Lavrenčič, son of Andrej, from Kopriva (1896-Col, 1943).
2. **Kopriva, former St. Laurentius Church:** narthex, 1740. Mason Jurij Skrinjar (birth location unknown, ca. 1702-Šepulje 1758).
3. **Tomaj, Church of the Virgin Mary in Britof,** 1644. Attributed to master mason Jernej Kraševac from Postojna and mason Matej Gorup.
4. **Tomaj, Saints Peter and Paul Church,** 1639-1640. Master mason Jernej Kraševac from Postojna (mentioned in written sources 1638-1640, 1643-1645).
5. **Tomaj, wayside chapel, named Uzmanov pil or Pil na placu,** 1897; 1946 transferred to the current position. Stonemason Andrej Lavrenčič from Kopriva (1858-1918).
6. **Kreplje, former wayside chapel at Kompare' homestead,** 1875. Stonemason Pavel Puppis from Tomaj (1804-1881).
7. **Šepulje, St. Anthony the Abbot Church:** narthex, 1738-1739. Mason Jurij Skrinjar (birth location unknown, ca. 1702-Šepulje 1758).
8. **Povir, Church of the Assumption in Gura.** Master mason Jernej Kraševac from Postojna. Bell tower 1863. Master mason Mihael Blažko from Lokavec (1810-1897).
9. **Povir, St. Peter Church:** roof renovated 1751-1752. Slates prepared by Gregor Kariž from Povir (1708-1770) and Valentin Skrinjar (Škrinjar) from Mercé (1696-?).
10. **Gradišče pri Divači, St. Helen Church,** 1653. Attributed to master mason Gašper Perhavec from Dolne Ležeče (probably first decennial of the 17th century-before 1678) and sibling stonemasons Andrej and Ivan Cerkvenik from Gradišče pri Divači.
11. **Dane pri Divači 17, Anžin (Ježin),** courtyard porton with stone slate gable roof, 1857. Self-taught stonemason Martin Felicijan, Dane pri Divači (1820-1895).

## ISTRIA

12. **Mihele/Draga, St. Elijah Church:** presbytery 1663. Master mason and stonemason Anže Felicijan the Elder from Rodik (birth location unknown, before 1620-ca. 1680, death location unknown).

## BRKINI WITH SURROUNDINGS

13. **Hrpelje, St. Helen Church, now St. Anthony the Abbot Church,** 1661-1670. Master mason and stonemason Anže Rojna from Brezovica (birth location unknown, ca. 1630-1687, Brezovica).
14. **Rodik, Church of the Holy Trinity and its narthex,** 1666, 1677. Master mason and stonemason Anže Felicijan the Elder from Rodik (birth location unknown, before 1620-ca. 1680, death location unknown).
15. **Tabor nad Baćem pri Materiji, St. George Church:** former roof of the narthex, 1675-1676. Master mason and stonemason Anže Rojna from Brezovica (birth location unknown, ca. 1630-1687, Brezovica).

## CARSO (Italy)

16. **Zolla - Col, Tabor, Church of the Assumption,** 1749-1753. Mason Matija Godnič.

## UPPER VIPAVA VALLEY

17. **Nanos, St. Hieronymus Church:** bell tower 1776. Mason Anton Galc, Lozice 33, Gavcovi (1712 - 1780).
